



## Asparagus Season 2021 in Singapore

In this year's spargel (asparagus) season, food & beverage logistics Singapore had an honor to assist a major importer to bring it in!

White asparagus is harvested from around mid-April to the end of June traditionally. Low in calories, yet packing tons of nutrients, asparagus has become a culinary symbol for many Germans this time of the year.

Not even the pandemic can stop importers to bring in this delicate produce!

In order to make this possible, we have to look for direct and shortest flight options from Germany to Singapore in order to keep the asparagus in pristine condition. We also have contingency plans put in place in the event we face cancellations, especially during this very unpredictable time.

Upon arrival in Singapore, the products are quickly cleared from the terminal within 2-3 hours and ready to be sent to supermarkets and restaurants for all of us to enjoy!
